I. BACKGROUND

[1] On July 16, 2009, the Inspector, Southern Region, Environmental Management, Alberta Environment, issued Reclamation Certificate No. 00252804-00-00 to ConocoPhillips Canada Ltd. for the reclamation of the Crestar 100 Little Bow well located at SE 17-015-19-W4M, near Lomond, Alberta.

[2] On September 22, 2009, the Board received a Notice of Appeal from Mr. Ronald Dodds, the landowner.

[3] A mediation meeting was scheduled for December 15, 2009, however, on November 10, 2009, the Appellant advised in a telephone conversation with Board staff that he had reached an agreement with ConocoPhillips and was withdrawing his appeal.

II. DECISION

[4] Pursuant to section 95(7) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* and based on the withdrawal of the appeal by Mr. Ronald Dodds, the Board hereby discontinues its proceedings in Appeal No. 09-018.
