## **I. BACKGROUND**

[1] On December 10, 2009, the Inspector, Northern Region, Environmental Management, Alberta Environment, issued Reclamation Certificate No. 00255351-00-00 under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. E-12, to ConocoPhillips Canada (BRC) Ltd. with respect to the Canrise Bear Canyon 6-22-82-12-W6M well in Saddle Hills County.

[2] On January 7, 2010, the Environmental Appeals Board received a Notice of Appeal from Mr. Danny Sorensen, the landowner, appealing the Reclamation Certificate.

[3] On January 26, 2010, the Board received an e-mail from ConocoPhillips (BRC) Ltd. advising of their intention to discuss the appeal with Mr. Sorensen, and on March 3, 2010 the Board received an e-mail from Mr. Sorensen advising that he was withdrawing his appeal.

## **II. DECISION**

[4] Pursuant to section 95(7) of the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, and based upon the withdrawal of the appeal by Mr. Sorensen, the Board hereby discontinues its proceedings in Appeal No. 09-038 and closes its file.
