Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board hearing scheduled for October 25, and 26, 2011, in Calgary has been adjourned in consultation with the parties. It is being rescheduled to the week of November 21, 2011.

The hearing was with respect to appeals filed by Gas Plus and Handel Transport regarding the December 3, 2010 decision of Alberta Environment and Water to issue an Environmental Protection Order and three subsequent amendments to the Order, to Gas Plus and Handel Transport. The Orders are for the remediation of a retail gas station located at 6336 Bowness Road NW in Calgary. Although the hearing has been adjourned, the Orders remain in place.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Water. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
