

# Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board hearing scheduled for October 22 and 23, 2013 in Calgary has been adjourned as a result of further discussions between the parties with respect to addressing the Order and the flooding concerns around Cochrane Lake.

An appeal was filed by Regional Water Services Ltd. and Jeff Colvin with the Board in relation to Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development's decision to issue Water Management Order No. WMO-2012/02-SR under the Water Act to Regional Water Services and Mr. Colvin for failing to maintain the water level of Cochrane Lake, located in Rocky View County, in accordance with their Licence No. 00186639-00-00 thereby causing an adverse effect to adjacent properties.

The hearing scheduled for October 22 and 23, 2013 has been adjourned at the request of Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development and the Appellants. The parties are working on an agreement to resolve the appeal and address the concerns at Cochrane Lake.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
