## Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board hearing scheduled for July 25, 2012 in Lethbridge has been adjourned as a result of an interim agreement reached at mediation.

The hearing was with respect to an appeal filed by Peter deGraaf and deGraaf Farming in relation to Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development's decision to issue an Enforcement Order to Peter deGraaf and deGraaf Farming for the infilling of a wetland without an approval at SE Section 19, Township 13, Range 17, West of the 4th Meridian, near Vauxhall, Alberta.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
