# Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule: Town of High River

The Environmental Appeals Board will conduct a hearing on January 12 and 13, 2021, via video conference, commencing at 8:30 am.

The Board will hear submissions with respect to the decision of Alberta Environment and Parks to issue to the Town of High River *Water Act* Approval No. 00419723-00-00. The Approval authorizes the construction and placement of a berm and swale within the flood plain of the Highwood River resulting in the permanent alteration of the flow, direction of flow and water levels, changing the location of water for drainage purposes, and maintaining, removing, or disturbing ground, vegetation or other material in or on any land, water or waterbody. The locations of the activities are sections 35-018-29-W4M and S½-01-019-29-W4M in the Town of High River.

Applications to intervene were due October 28, 2020. The Board received requests to intervene and one request to intervene was granted.

Since the hearing is being held via video conference, it will not be open to the public for viewing. You may request a copy of the audio recording.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Parks. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
