## **Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule: Landrex Hunter Ridge Hearing**

The Environmental Appeals Board will conduct a hearing by written submissions commencing April 30, 2021.

The Board will receive submissions with respect to the August 26, 2020 decision of the Director, Alberta Environment and Parks, to issue Approval No. 00425700-00-00 under the *Water Act* to Landrex Hunter Ridge Inc. for: altering, infilling and removing wetlands; constructing, dewatering, operating, and carrying out maintenance of drainage works, bypass ditch, erosion control works, culverts and berms; and constructing, dewatering, operating, and carrying out maintenance of storm water management systems, for the Erin Ridge North development located at W½ 21-54-25-W4M in St. Albert, Alberta.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Parks. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.

Any person, other than the parties, who wishes to make a representation before the Board on this appeal must submit a request by fax or by e-mail to the Board. The request must be received by the Board on or before April 14, 2021. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that their request has been received. The request shall (a) contain the name, address, e-mail, and telephone and fax numbers of the person submitting the request, (b) indicate whether the person submitting the request intends to be represented by a lawyer or agent and, if so, the name of the lawyer or agent, and (c) contain a summary of the nature of the person's interest in this appeal. Applications will only be considered if the information will assist the Board in making its decision, and will not duplicate the information provided by the parties. After April 14, 2021, the Board will determine if other persons may make representations.

Please contact the Board for further information regarding this appeal.

The information requested is necessary to allow the Environmental Appeals Board to perform its function. The information is collected under the authority of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, section 33(c). Section 33(c) provides that personal information may only be collected if that information relates directly to and is necessary for the processing of this appeal. The information you provide will be considered a public record.
