The Environmental Appeals Board will conduct a hearing on November 16 and 17, 2023 in Calgary.

The Board will hear submissions with respect to the November 4, 2022 decision of the Director, Alberta Environment and Protected Areas, to issue *Water Act* Preliminary Certificate No. 00346962-00-00 to Ian MacGregor for the Carraig Ridge Development in the MD of Bighorn No. 8. The Preliminary Certificate states Ian MacGregor will receive a Licence to operate works and divert up to 6,205 cubic metres of water per year at a maximum diversion rate of 22 cubic metres of water per day, from the source of water, at the point of diversion Well ID 1022302 (WSW 7711) in NW 09-026-W5M, for municipal purposes (subdivision water supply) with a priority of 2014-01-28-001, upon compliance with the conditions in the Preliminary Certificate.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Protected Areas. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.

Any person, other than the parties, who wishes to make a representation before the Board on this appeal must submit a request by fax or by e-mail to the Board. The request must be received by the Board on or before August 24, 2023. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that their request has been received. The request shall (a) contain the name, address, e-mail, and telephone and fax numbers of the person submitting the request, (b) indicate whether the person submitting the request intends to be represented by a lawyer or agent and, if so, the name of the lawyer or agent, and (c) contain a summary of the nature of the person's interest in this appeal. Applications will only be considered if the information will assist the Board in making its decision, and will not duplicate the information provided by the parties. After August 24, 2023, the Board will determine if other persons may make representations and the manner in which they can be made.

The information requested is necessary to allow the Environmental Appeals Board to perform its function. The information is collected under the authority of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, section 33(c). Section 33(c) provides that personal information may only be collected if that information relates directly to and is necessary for the processing of this appeal. The information you provide will be considered a public record.
