

# Environmental Appeals Board hearing schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board will conduct a hearing on January 23, 2014, commencing at 8:30 a.m. at the Centennial Senior Citizens Opportunity Club in St. Paul.

The Board will hear submissions with respect to appeals filed in relation to Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development's decision to issue *Water Act* Approval No. 00297021-00-00 to the County of St. Paul for filling in a water body at W ½ 04-059-10-W4M for the construction of a new section of road (Range Road 104 near Owlseye), in the County of St. Paul.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Sustainable Resource Development. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.

Any person, other than the parties, who wishes to make a representation before the Board on these appeals must submit a request by fax or by e-mail to the Board. The request must be received by the Board on or before November 26, 2013. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the request has been received. Such a request shall (a) contain the name, address, e-mail, and telephone and fax numbers of the person submitting the request, (b) indicate whether the person submitting the request intends to be represented by a lawyer or agent and, if so, the name of the lawyer or agent, and (c) contain a summary of the nature of the person's interest in these appeals.

Applications will only be considered if the information will assist the Board in making its decision, and will not duplicate the information provided by the parties. After November 26, 2013, the Board will, in its discretion, determine if other persons may make representations, and the manner in which they can be made. Once the Board makes a decision on any intervenor applications, the hearing will be open to the public for viewing only.

Copies of material filed with the Board respecting these appeals are available for viewing at the St. Paul Municipal Library, 4802-53 Street, St. Paul, Alberta, during its normal operating hours, or by appointment at the office of the Environmental Appeals Board in Edmonton.

The information requested is necessary to allow the Environmental Appeals Board to perform its function. The information is collected under the authority of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, section 33(c). Section 33(c) provides that personal information may only be collected if that information relates directly to and is necessary for the processing of these appeals. The information you provide will be considered a public record.
