The Environmental Appeals Board will conduct a hearing on November 25, 2020, via video conference, commencing at 8:30 am.

The Board will hear submissions with respect to the decision of Alberta Environment and Parks to issue to Thorlakson Nature's Call Administrative Penalty No. EPEA-19/10-AP-SSR-20/01 in the amount of \$1,486,861.49 for alleged contraventions at their Class 1 composting facility in Airdrie, Alberta.

Applications to intervene in the hearing were due October 28, 2020. The Board received one application and that application was denied.

Since the hearing is being held via video conference, it will not be open to the public for viewing. You may request a copy of the audio recording.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Parks. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
